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MASTER PLANNING FOR THE TOWN OF ST GEORGE

OVERALL APPROACH:

- The Corporation understands the need to engage in broad stakeholder consultation and relevant master planning investigations to obtain the best data to be able to plan effectively and strategically for the community.
- Existing Bermuda Plan can likely be retained as the overarching land use planning tool; however.
- Town should have other layers of strategic and growth enhancing documents overlain in the Plan to help to refine and articulate the town's specific needs, intentions and directions.
- A phased approach is proposed



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MASTER PLANNING FOR THE TOWN OF ST GEORGE

APPROACH

Phase 1

- In-depth review and development of existing data (August – October)
- Design and implementation of a stakeholder consultation process to obtain broad input and ascertain community issues, needs, wishes, constraints, assets and ideas for ways forward.

Stakeholders include: **Town Council, Areas businesses, Residents, Special interest groups.**

Phase 2

- Identify immediate/short, and longer term needs
- Determine how these can be delivered, and with what tools, e.g. Infrastructure Plan/s – water, wastewater, solid waste; Traffic, Parking and Circulation Plan, Resiliency Strategy, Public Spaces Plan, Wayfinding, enhancement to the Economic Empowerment Zone etc.

Phase 3

- Develop the selected tools



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MASTER PLANNING FOR THE TOWN OF ST GEORGE

PRELIMINARY NEEDS IDENTIFIED BY CORPORATION:

- Enhancing existing infrastructure
- Functioning of existing and future land uses
- Options for pedestrianizing Water Street - a portion of, and or/periodically
- Parking concerns and locations for installation of electric vehicle recharge stations and small vehicle parking
- Enhancing the aesthetics and functionality of Town Square
- Flooding issues
- Addressing derelict structures
